Beam Returns

- Unfortunate series of events
 - Since June, we've been down as much as up
 - The times we were up were mostly when machines were tuning back up after the Shutdown
 - Never did better than about 70% of last winter's running conditions
 - Machines have been running well for the past few weeks – when we've been down

Experiment Operations
